## General Information About the University

Every year we are educating 38 115 bachelor degree students, 9 519 master degree students and 26 178 two years programme students. In results its giving the number of 73 812 students.

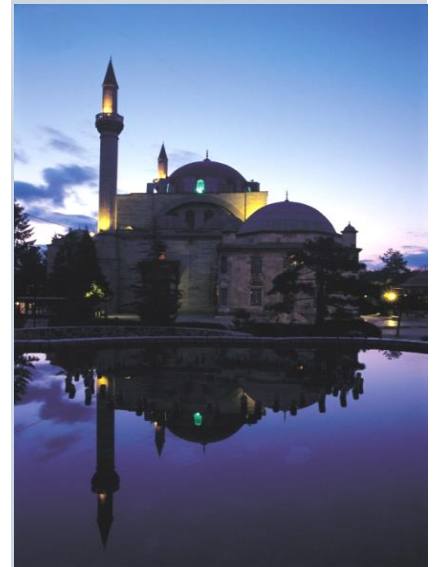


## City of Konya

Konya is an old byzantian and roman city. Konya is full of interesting heritage, which comes from early turkish and Islam culture. The most interesting point on the map in Konya is Mevlana museum, located close to the city center, near the mosque from XVI century. In that times, building was a home for Mevlana – Rumi, person who has created Whirling dervishes group.

Charm of the city was described in the Bible: In the central plateau of the Lycaonian District, Iconium was a city

set amidst a very large fertile plain that stretched to the north and east. Well watered and surrounded by an unusually productive and stoneless alluvial soil, the farms of the region are still some of modern Turkey's finest for grains, orchards of plums and apricots. Dz 13: 51.
