

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROJECTS

Prison Education Project - Cezaevi Eđitim Projesi

With a protocol signed between our Rectory and Konya Public Prosecutor's Office, the social responsibility project was carried out for educating prisoners and criminals in Konya E Type Closed Penal Institution. 36 lecturers and 41 students voluntarily participated in the project, which involved a 27-hour- lesson program and a series of activities in a nine-week period.

Health Town Education Project

Within the scope of educational, cultural, social and sports social responsibility project organized for the Health Town and the Health Primary School in Meram District, Konya by Selcuk University Rectory and Konya Provincial Directorate of National Education, the multi-directional education started to be given to students in the primary school and kindergarten in the town. 37 volunteering lecturers and students went to the town for 4 days a week, gave education to the students in many fields from Turkish and Maths to chess, from English to pre-school education, and assumed the role of volunteer older sisters and brothers.



İHSAN DOĞRAMACI PRACTICE KINDERGARTEN

İhsan Doğramacı Practice Kindergarten is a practice school for students who study at the departments of Child Development and Education Teaching and Pre-School Education Teaching in Vocational Education Faculty, Selcuk University. Within the scope of the project named 'From Neonate To University' a nursery school and a kindergarten were built on Campus, and this has filled an important gap. This school, whose interior was designed to meet children's needs, provides a different environment for students, and the service given is an important factor in their parents' choices. The school, which was built by taking all details into consideration from game rooms to lounges and gardens appropriate for themselves, is a product of modern understanding.



The institution started to carry out 'Montessori Education Model' applied in international field as an alternative education model for the students in the education program between the ages of 3 and 6 in the academic year of 2007-2008.
