"Selçuk University International Application and Research Centre of Excellence in Pharmacy" does not currently have any research and application activities as its infrastructure work is still ongoing. In addition, applications are made for Project Calls that will support the development of the Centre. The last of these projects is the Project titled "Obtaining Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients from Natural Resources and In-Vitro/In-Vivo Evaluation of New Formulations to be Developed", which was made in response to the "Call for High Technology Platforms" published within the scope of the "TÜBİTAK 1004 Program" in September 2018. The project proposal was deemed suitable to be supported with a support budget of 75,000 TL for Phase I studies.

After adequate infrastructure facilities are provided, our Centre aims to carry out the following R&D activities and contribute to the development of sustainable products based on university-industry cooperation.

- Performing raw material and conventional drug analyzes needed by the pharmaceutical industry, research units and universities,
- Designing new and innovative drug systems using high technologies,
- Developing high value added products from natural resources and
- Supporting the production of equivalent drugs by dissolving original drug formulations.
